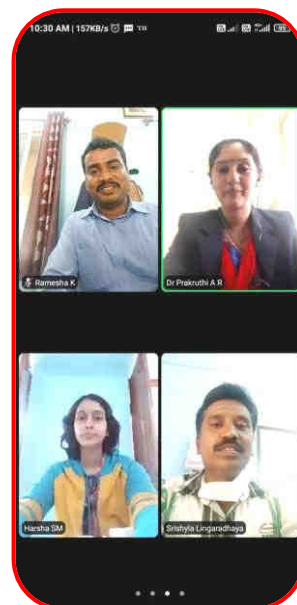
Report of Guest Lecture on “Women Political Empowerment in India”

Date: 09.11.2020

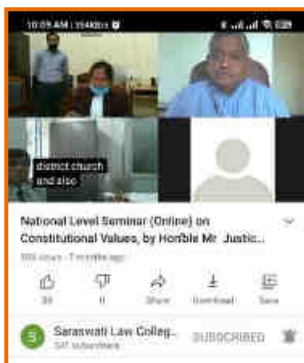

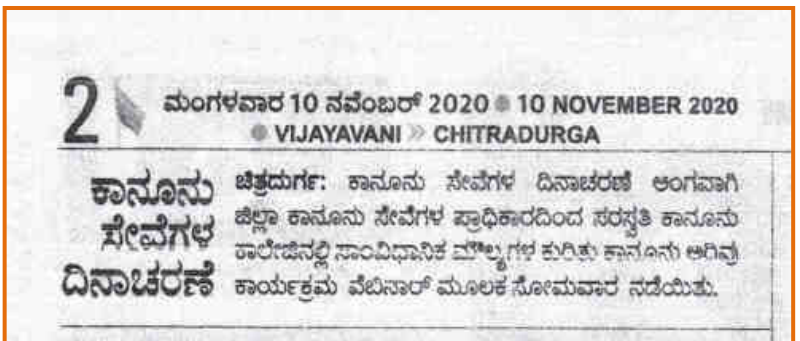

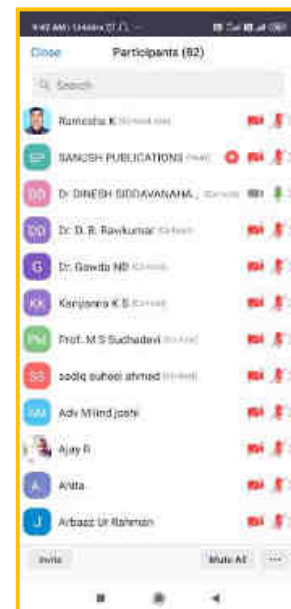
Report of National Level Seminar (online) on “Human Rights under Indian Constitution”
