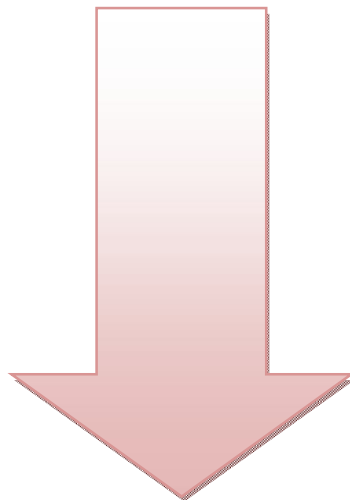

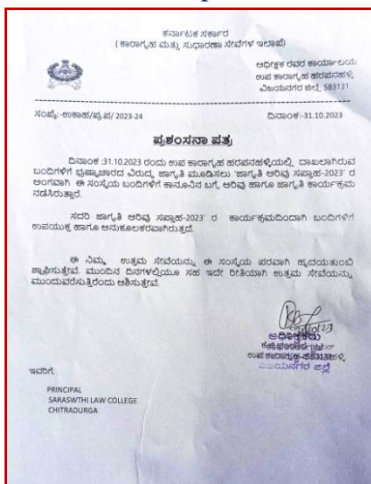

## **Report of Awareness Programme on the occasion of Constitution Day**

**Date: 27.11.2023**

The Institution has organized Constitution Day celebration on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2023. The objectives of the programme is to create awareness about Constitution to sensitize the students and public about importance of Constitution Day.

The programme began in the ground after the assembly took over, by Oath taking ceremony carried by Shri. P.C. Murugeshappa, Physical Education Director. It was followed by plantation drive as a symbol of National Environmental Awareness Month.

On this occasion an awareness programme was arranged by the Institution in association with District Legal Services Authority and Advocates Association, Chitradurga at 9:45am in Vakeelara Bhavana, Chitradurga. This programme began with the State Anthem record. It was followed by welcome speech and inauguration through showering flowers to Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and Mahathma Gandhiji's portraits by all the dignitaries on the dais.


The key note address was delivered by Shri. M. Vijay, Member Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Chitradurga. It was followed by inaugural speech. Hon'ble Shri. Kemparaju, Principal Senior Civil Judge and CJM, Chitradurga preached the preamble of the India Constitution, which was recited by the gathering. In his speech he said that this programme is to cherish the glory and reaffirm our commitment to honour the ideology of Great Indian Constitution. The sole object of this programme is to understand the value of Constitution and spread it to the future generation. The Constitution inspired to live in unity and peace. To lead a satisfactory life one should read, understand and adopt the Constitutional Principles.

Shri. S. Vijaykumar, Advocate, Chitradurga delivered lecture on "Significance of Preamble". He said that the aims and aspiration of Constitution is Preamble as discussed under Keshavananda Bharathi case. It is a key note indicator, which expresses the soveirnity, secularism, socialistic, republic and democratic. He gave examples of cases from Sayeera Banu to Golaknath case and Minerva Mill's case. He concluded by saying that advocates are the guardians of the Constitution.

The Preamble is aiming to secure, justice, liberty, equality to all citizens and promote fraternity to maintain unity and integrity of the nation, these were stressed in her speech.

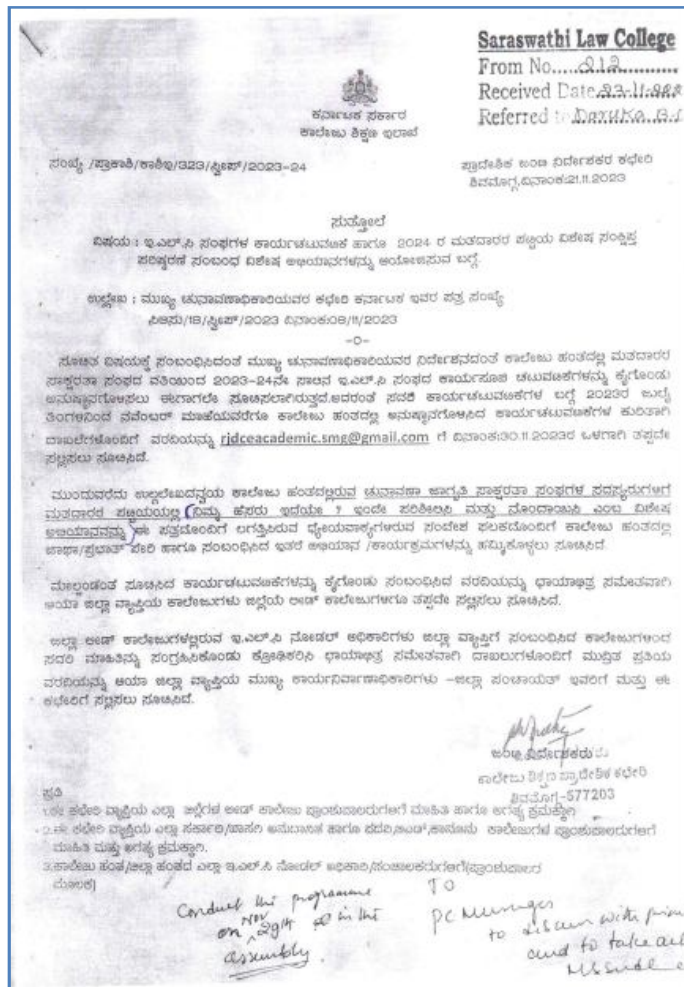

Date: 29.11.2023

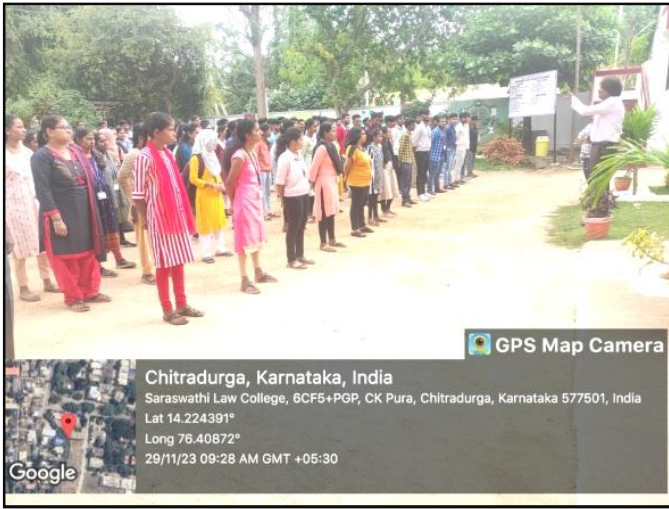

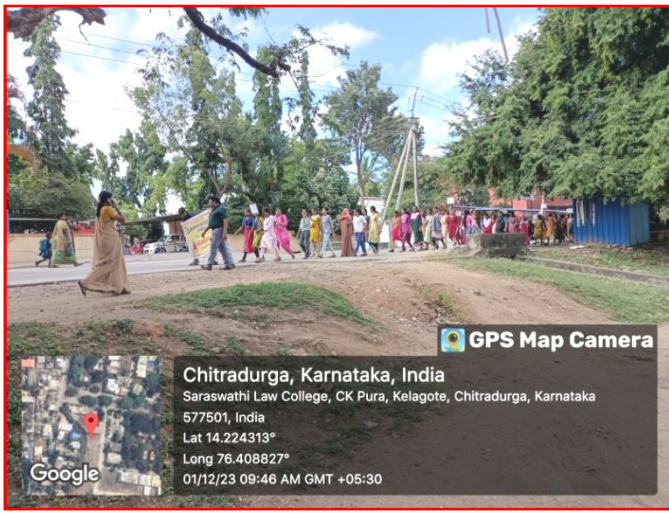

Date: 14.12.2023

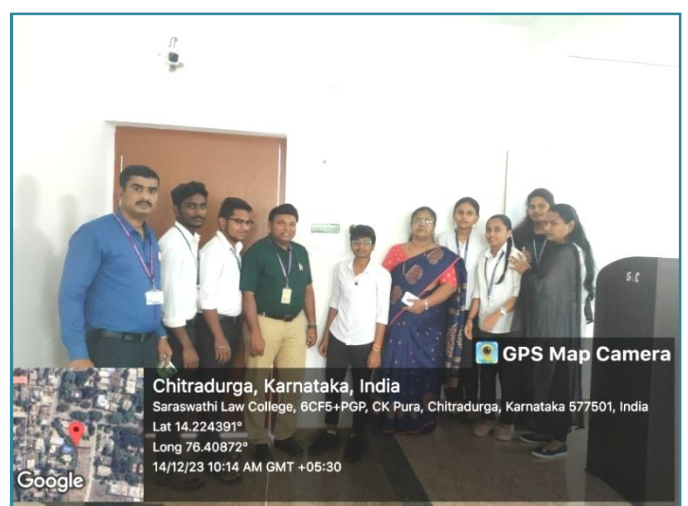

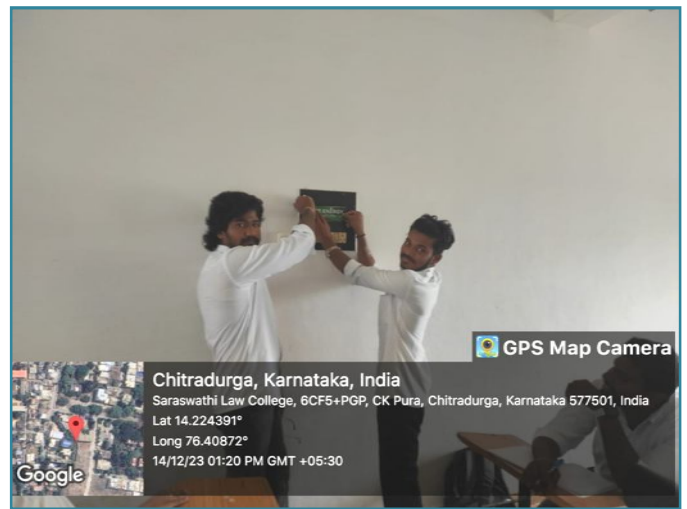

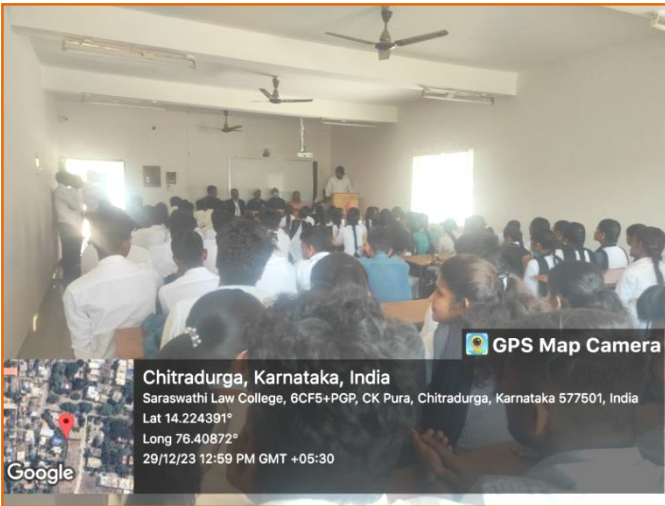

Hence, being educated it is our primary duty to take precautionary measures to prevent such virus.

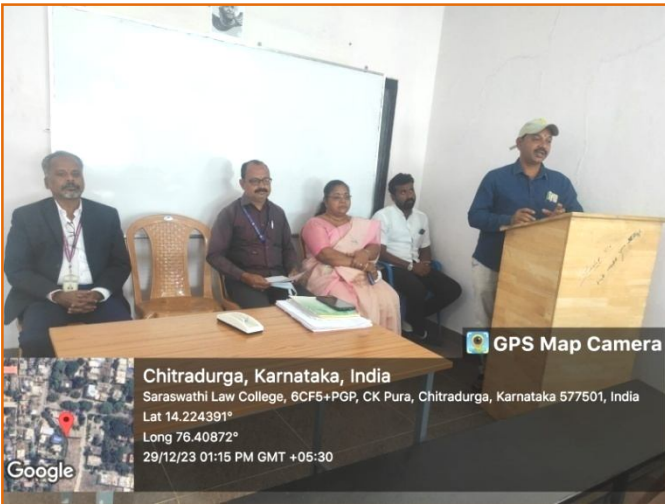

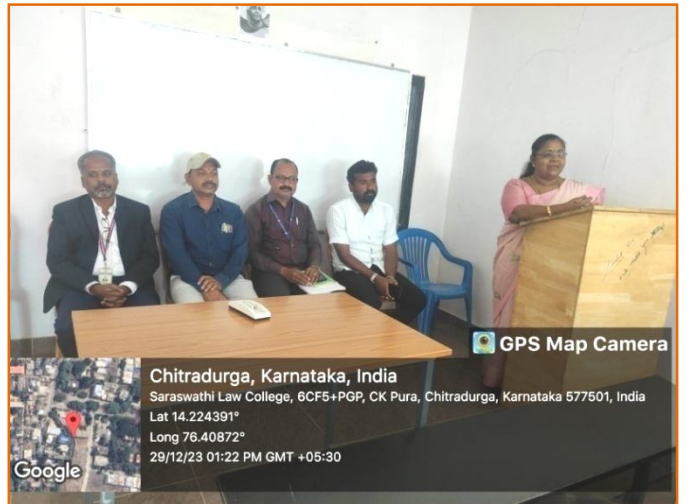

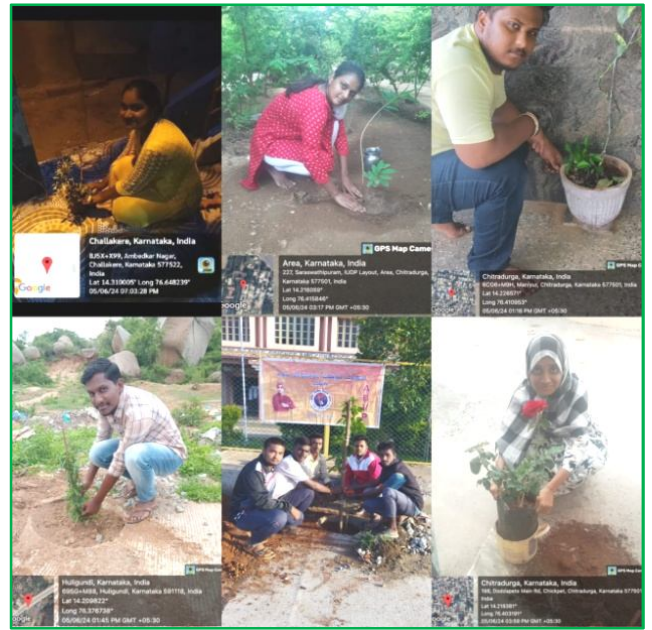

## **Report on Special Lecture on “Decline of Social Values and its Effects**

**Date: 08.07.2024**

The Institution had organized a Special Lecture on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2024 at 12:00 pm in Golden Jubilee Auditorium, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga. The program was commenced by Sri P. C. Murugesappa, Physical Education Director, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga. It began with the Invocation song sung in a patriotic mood by student Bhoomika G R and team. It was followed by Pledge taking ceremony carried by Sri P. C. Murugesappa, Physical Education Director.

Prof. Dr. M. S. Sudhadevi, Principal, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga highlighted the bird view about the college, significance of the ceremony to students and welcomed the dignitaries and gathering followed by lighting of the inaugural lamp lit by the Hon'ble Justice Shri. N. Santosh Hegde, Former Judge of Supreme Court of India, Former Solicitor General of India and Former Lokayuktha, Karnataka and other dignitaries on the dais.

Smt. Harsha. S.M., Assistant Professor, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga gave an introduction of Hon'ble Justice Shri. N. Santosh Hegde, Former Judge of Supreme Court of India, Former Solicitor General of India and Former Lokayuktha, Karnataka, which was followed by Inaugural speech.

Hon'ble Justice Shri. N. Santosh Hegde, addressed the gathering by informing the students when and where the prefix are to be used for the name and cited the Supreme Court case law which holds good regarding the matter. He also cited examples of specific cases where he witnessed corruption in administration from various forms of public services. “We cannot blame individuals because this fault lies with society. Earlier, there was social centralization of criminals; and role of families, parents and moral science education were significant in shaping our minds. But today, the social fabric itself has changed. Unfortunately, today's society respects only money and power, while honesty often takes a backseat.”

“Only education cannot give value to the society. Our objectives and attitudes should also be good. When the students become employees in future, they should fight against the corruption. Corruption is rampant in all the four pillars of the Constitution like Legislature, Executive, Judiciary and Media. It's unfortunate that there are no serious discussions and debates in Parliament and Assembly. Our elected representatives have been spending time in meaningless debates or commotions. As a result, public money is being wasted”, he said.

He reminded some of the major scams to have plagued our country for the past few decades and as to the huge amounts of public money that were siphoned off from administration. "Such people are not afraid of law. No one wants to bring about change and blame game becomes the order of the day. Where is democracy and how can true development happen in this kind of a situation? What is the way out of this to bring about peace and solidarity of the nation?" he left the question open to the audience.

He also spoke about the mining report that he authored which was released in 2011, saying his recommendations were not implemented by successive governments. "The only way out of this rut of ever-increasing greed is inculcating a value of contentment. Be content with what you legitimately have. I know a lot of dedication and determination is required for this. But once it is accomplished, any amount of temptation can be countered."

His talk was followed by a Q&A session with the audience, during which he suggested that to fight when the system itself is choked, people within and outside the system should be willing to change. "The time has come to reduce the number of appeal forums and thereby speculative litigation, which will result in quicker decisions by the Judiciary."

To another query about making policies more people-centric, he suggested, "Confine the Supreme Court for constitutional matters only. For policy matters a different forum should be created. Around 25 questions were posed by the students and all those were answered in a most zealous and patience manner by Hon'ble Justice Shri. N. Santosh Hegde. Further more questions from students were waiting in a queue, but due to time constraints it was necessary to end the program.

Felicitation was made to Hon'ble Justice Shri. N. Santosh Hegde by Sri Fathyarajan, Senior Advocate, Vice President, Saraswathi Education Society, Chitradurga, and Smt. D. K. Sheela, Senior Advocate, Secretary, Saraswathi Education Society, Chitradurga, with Shawl, Garland, Fruit box, Memento. Student Law Forum members also felicitated Hon'ble Justice Shri. N. Santosh Hegde with Shawl and memento.

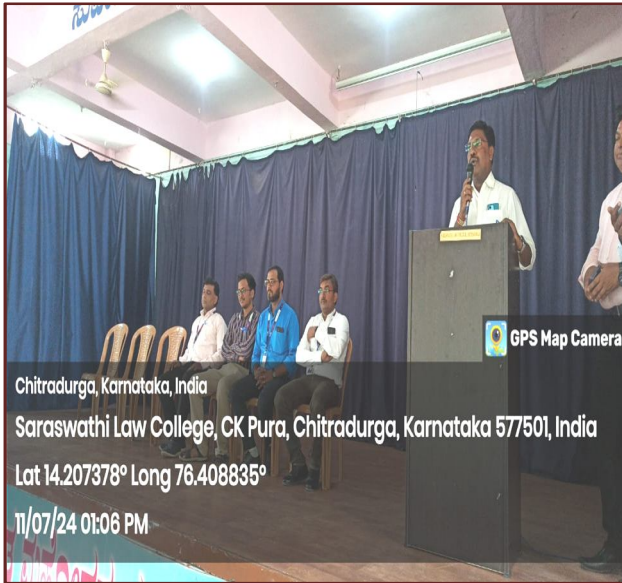
The State Bank of India Representative

had addressed the students and said "For a college going student, from the beginning of the admission i.e. at the time of online application they required to make online payments through e-wallets Google pay, debit and credit cards etc., and also for paying exam fees and for getting scholarship banking services are much important. Thus day by day they face a lot of problems with related to banking services and activities." He also narrated the different services provided by banks to the public and also assessed the awareness of college students of these services.

He further said, Banks provide security and convenience form aging money and sometimes allow making money by earning interest. Convenience and fees are two of the most important things to consider when choosing a bank. All banks have rules about how long it takes to access deposits, how many debit card transactions allowed in a day, and how much cash withdraw from an ATM. While Debit cards encourage more responsible spending than credit cards, they do not offer the same protection or perks to customers. He also said, to protect money from electronic theft, identity theft, and other forms of fraud, it's important to implement basic precautions such as shredding account statements, having complex passwords and only doing online banking through secure internet connections.

The program was concluded through proposing vote of thanks delivered by Bhargav Sen, student of final year 3 years LL.B. Around 280 students took the benefit of this awareness program.

## **Report on creating Awareness about POCSO Act and The Prohibition of Child Marriage Act among school Children**

**Date: 28.08.2024**

The Institution Organized an awareness programme on POCSO Act and Child Marriage in Agasanakallu Government School, Chitradurga on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2024. The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 for short POSCO Act and The Prohibition of Child Marriage Act 2006 is an important concept to be sensitized to the children, because Schools are environments where children spend a significant amount of their time. Awareness will ensure that children are protected from sexual offences at school. Educating students about their rights and how to recognize and report abuse can empower them to protect themselves and others

The programme was compared by Smt. Manjula. M. R, Social Teacher Agasanakallu High School, Chitradurga. It began with a warm welcome speech delivered by Sri Karibasappa. K, Hindi Teacher, Agasanakallu High School, Chitradurga.

The resource person of the programme was Prof. Dr. M. S. Sudhadevi, Principal, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga. She raised awareness on good touch and bad touch and highlighted the POSCO Act. She further informed that even the death penalty can be awarded for committing sexual crimes on children. Considering the gravity of sexual crimes on children, she exhorted the children to report such cases to the Parents or Teachers or the person whom they trust so as to bring a complaint to the police station to award stringent punishment to the perpetrators as per law.

Smt. Harsha. S. M., Assistant Professor, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga addressed the gathering and said Child Marriage is a toxic that ruins young lives. Many a time, early marriages are done to bring child brides into forced household chores. This has a serious burden on young girls which leads to health, safety, bodily integrity and self determination issues. She also quoted that many are not even aware of the correct legal age of marriage for girls and boys. Thus, awareness within the community is very much required. She made the program more interesting by explaining

how children and parents will be trapped to child marriage with a short story. She explained the topic by putting different examples. The children were also informed about child Help line-1098 and 112 and advised to report any case of child abuse or child marriage or any trouble.

Smt. Uma Maheshwari, Head Mistress, Agasanakallu Middle School, Chitradurga addressed the gathering and said that the child victim of sexual offence could be a boy or a girl both can seek a protection under POCSO Act and the offender too can be male or a female both can be punished alike. Regarding child marriage the law is armed with enabling provisions to prohibit child marriage, protect and provide relief to victim and enhance punishment for those who abet, promote or solemnize such marriage.

Sri Thippeswamy H. M. HeadMaster, Agasanakallu High School, Chitradurga delivered the presidential address and said that this awareness programme aimed to educate students about the laws and empower the children to identify signs of abuse or coercion and raise their voice against wrong activities made to them and be in a protective zone. He also highlighted that the parents and guardians should be aware of the provisions of the child welfare Acts in place for its effective implementation.
