MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

1. The Society be called "SARASWATHI EDUCATION SOCIETY" C.K. PURA EXTENSION, CHITRADURGA referred to herein after as the Society.
2. The Head-quarters of the society shall be at Chitradurga City.
3. The Society shall be a body corporate with a common seal inscribed there on "THE SARASWATHI EDUCATION SOCIETY, CHITRADURGA".
4. OBJECTS : -
 - a) To initiate and advance Legal Education through the Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga.
 - b) To establish Colleges, Schools, Hostels and other Educational Institutions of various kinds including Technical, Medical, Professional and Specialised Courses etc.,
 - c) To take over of affiliate Colleges and schools belonging to or managed by other similar Educational Societies for the purpose of Management and control.
 - d) The Society shall be purely charitable institution and Non-Political and Non-Communal in Character.
 - e) To do all incidental and supplemental acts to promote the above objects.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Society shall be called "THE SARASWATHI EDUCATION SOCIETY, C.K. PURA EXTENSION, CHITRADURGA" referred to here in after as the Society.

2. The Head-quarters of the Society shall be at Chitradurga City.
3. The Society shall be a body corporate and shall have a common seal, inscribed thereon "The Saraswathi Education Society, C.K. Pura Extension, Chitradurga" with a right to sue and be sued in its corporate name. The Official year of the society shall be from 1st April of each English calendar year to the 31st March of the next English Calendar.

4. OBJECTS :-

- a) To initiate and advance Legal Education through the Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga.
- b) To establish Colleges, Schools, Hostels and other Educational Institutions of various kinds including Technical, Professional, Medical and Specialised Courses etc.,
- c) To take over, of affiliate colleges and schools belonging to, or managed by other similar Education Societies for the purpose of management and control.
- d) The Society shall be purely a Charitable Institution being non-political and non-communal in character.
- e) To do all incidental and supplemental to carryout and to promote the above objects.

5. MEMBERSHIP :-

The Membership of the society shall consist of the following members admitted as such by the Governing Body.

i) Life Members, ii) Ordinary Members, iii) Fellows.

- a) A Life Members is one who subscribed to the objects of the society and pays a sum of Rs. 500/- or more to the Society.
- b) Fellows : Students of the Institutions run by this society, who has completed the course can become the member by paying sum of Rs. 100/- or more.

- c) Ordinary member is one who pays a sum of Rs. 100/- or more to the society.

6. ADMISSION OF MEMBERS :-

- a) Any Person who is a major and desirous of being a member of the society shall file an application in the prescribed form to the secretary of the society along with prescribed membership fee with registration fee of Rs. 10/-.
- b) The said application shall be placed before the Governing Body for its approval.
- c) The Governing Body may reject any application without assigning any reason.
- d) All the categories of members hither to were members of the society in different categories should be deemed to be life members of the society except ordinary members and fellows.
- e) No Person shall be a member of the society, if he is an employee in any institution run by the society.
- f) A member of the society shall cease to be a member if he is :
 - i) Declared insolvent. OR
 - ii) Convicted by a competent court of law for any offence involving moral turpitude. OR
 - iii) Becomes insane OR lunatic, OR
 - iv) Resigns.
- g) If any member of the society acts against the interest of the society or denigrate the fair name of the society by his acts or omission, such member shall be removed by a resolution passed by the Governing body with 2/3rd majority present by the meeting.
- h) No new members shall be admitted with one month during election year prior to the date of General Body meeting.

7.
 - a) The General Body of the society shall consist of the Life Members, Ordinary Members and Fellows.
 - b) The General Body shall meet once a year.
 - c) A Special General Body meeting may be convened by the Governing Body at any time and shall be convened within One month on a written requisition of at least "THIRTY" members for the specific purpose. Fifteen clear days notice shall be given to all the members before the meeting is convened with notice of any proposition intended to be moved at the meeting. The quorum for the General Body shall be THIRTY members or One third of the total number of members whichever is less.
 - d) Elections shall be by show of hands, unless a majority of members present so desire, it shall be by secret ballot. In the event of equality of votes, the election shall be decided by lot among those, getting the same number of votes.
8. The duties and function of the General Body shall be the same as in the Act and Rules.
9. **GOVERNING BODY :-**
 - a) There shall be a Governing Body consisting of 13 members. The members of Governing Body shall be elected by the General Body, 7 from Life Members, 3 from Ordinary members and 3 from Fellows, whose duration shall be three years. The members of the Governing Body shall elect among themselves president, Vice-President and Secretary.
 - b) The Executive Authority of the society shall vest in the Governing Body.
 - c) The Governing Body shall be elected at a Triennial meeting of the General Body. It shall however hold office until a new Governing Body is elected.

- d) Vacancies arising during the term by resignation, death or otherwise shall be filled-up from among the members by co-option by the Governing Body.
 - e) The Head of the Institutions under the society shall be the Ex-Officio members of the Governing Body.
 - f) Seven clear days notice shall be given for convening a meeting of the Governing Body. Seven members form the quorum for such meeting. But in an emergency the president may call for such meeting at shorter notice.
 - g) The Governing Body shall be convened at least once in three months or as often as may be necessary.
10. At an adjourned meeting of either the General Body or Governing Body, if such adjournment is occasioned for want of quorum, no quorum shall be necessary in case the same agenda shall be considered.
11. **THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE GOVERNING BODY:**

The Governing Body will be Supreme Executive Body of the society and shall be vested with all the powers to conduct smooth functioning of the society and its Institutions.

 - a) To collect funds for the society.
 - b) To Control and arrange for the management of the Educational Institutions of the Society.
 - c) To control and manage the funds and the properties of the society and to recommend the annual report, accounts and budget to the General Body.
 - d) To accept membership of different categories of members.
 - e) To start new institutions and to take over the management of other existing institutions.
 - f) To submit the annual report and accounts to the General Body.

- g) To fix the remuneration of the auditors and the service conditions of the staff, their appointment and promotion.
- h) To take legal steps, whenever necessary in the interest of the society.
- i) To take such other action in the interest of the society not inconsistent with the Rules, Regulations of the society in accordance with Act and Rules.
- j) The Governing Body shall have power to raise loans with or without mortgage, improve, manage, develop, exchange, lease or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property of the society. To accept donation or Gifts or property for any general or specific purpose of the society, on condition or conditions not repugnant to the objects of the society.
- k) To appoint the staff of the society and its Institutions.

12. ADVISORY COMMITTEE :

There shall be an advisory Committee for each Institution consisting of Nine members, 3 members elected from among the body of the Fellow members in the General Meeting which shall be convened within two months from the date of opening the college and the rest be elected from among themselves by the Governing Body. They shall hold office until another Advisory Committee is constituted. The advisory Committee shall elect a president among the members of the Advisory Committee. The principals of the Institutions run by the society shall be the convener of the Advisory Committee.

- a) The Advisory Committee shall have all or any of the powers delegated by the Governing Body and which shall act as recommendatory body to the Governing Body.
- b) They shall generally function for running the day-to-day administration of the institutions deciding on routine matters and

recommend proposals regarding improvement of the Institutions subject to the control of the Governing Body.

- c) They shall meet once a month or as often as may be required. Five days notice shall be given for convening a meeting of the advisory Committee.
- d) The convener shall convene the meeting of the advisory committee after the preparation of the agenda in consultation with the president.
- e) The quorum for the meeting of the advisory committee shall be five.

13. a) PRESIDENT :

The President shall preside over all the meeting of the General Body, Governing Body and shall supervise the affairs of the society.

b) VICE – PRESIDENT :

The Vice-President shall have all powers of the president, in the absence of the president, provided the president has requested the Vice-President to function in his place during his absence. However if the president is absent for presiding over any meeting of the Governing Body or the General Body, the Vice-President shall preside over such meetings.

c) SECRETARY :

The Secretary of the Governing Body shall subject to the control of the president have powers to supervise the affairs of the society, be responsible for the upkeep and protection of the properties of the society, collect subscription cause to maintain accounts, issue receipts for the monies received and incur expenditure on valid vouchers and sign the books of accounts. He shall have powers to conduct all correspondence under his own signature, while bringing important matters to the notice of

the president. The Secretary shall be the officer to sue or be sued for and on behalf of the society.

14. The Governing Body shall have power to frame Rules and Bye-laws for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the society, inter alia functioning of the various sub-committees, it may constitute and for such other purposes, such rules and Bye-laws shall not be inconsistent with these Rules, Regulations of the Act.
15. The working hours of the society shall be 10-30 a.m. to 5-00 p.m. with an interval between 1-00 p.m. and 2-00 p.m.
16. Nothing here in laid shall invalidated any action taken under the above rules and in good faith merely on account of a technical irregularity of procedure.
17. For amending the Memorandum of Association and the Rules and Regulations, provision of section 09 and 10 of the Act shall be followed. Annual returns are filed with the Registrar as required under section 13 of the Act.
18. This Bye-law comes into effect immediately after the approval by the Registrar of Societies, Chitradurga District.



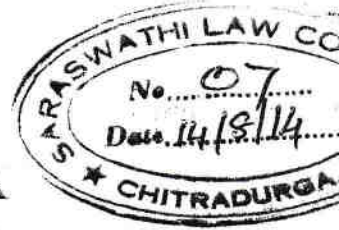

Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 12th July, 2014 considered the inspection report of the above mentioned college. After consideration, Committee made the following recommendations:-

The Legal Education Committee considered the inspection report submitted by the inspection team. After consideration, Committee is of the view that Saraswati Law College, Chitrdurga be granted approval of affiliation for running three year LL.B course and five year BA LL.B course with an intake of one section of 60 students in each section in each course for a period of three years i.e. for the academic year 2014-2015, 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 subject to the following conditions.

So far the question of granting approval of affiliation from the year 2009-2010 to 2013-2014, the office has informed that as against the two orders of the Bar Council of India dated 4th /5th September, 2009 and 11th November, 2011 stay order has been passed by the High Court in two different writ petitions respectively. There is nothing on record to show that any attempt has been made to get the Ex-party order vacated. Instructions should be given to the Advocate concerned in this regard for vacation of said order and upto date status report of the two writ petitions should be obtained from the advocate concerned.

Even if the college is continuing to admit students for the said period by virtue of High Court order, they must pay and deposit the requisite amount of inspection fee for every three years as per rules of the Bar Council of India for each of course shall be subject to the order to be passed by the High Court.



2. College should ensure the payment of salary to teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
3. The institution is directed to upgrade the library by investing minimum Rs. 50,000/- per year per stream.
4. Teacher Student ratio shall be as per Schedule-III, Rule-11, Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India Rules.

7. Within 6 months Moot Court furniture shall be changed.

Institution should submit affidavit in compliance to the above conditions within six weeks.

College authorities are also required to apply to the Bar Council of India for further extension of approval of affiliation six months in advance before expiry of the period of approval of affiliation granted by the Bar Council of India i.e. on or before 31st December, 2016 failing which a late fee will be charged.

Sir,

The Standing Committee (Sub-Committee) of the Legal Education Committee of the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 16th July, 2017 considered the inspection report of **Saraswati Law College, Chitradurga, Karnataka** submitted by the inspection team of the Bar Council of India. After consideration, the Committee is of the view that Saraswati Law College, Chitradurga, Karnataka be granted extension of approval of affiliation for imparting **three year LLB course** with intake of **two sections of 60 students** in each section and **five year BA.LLB course** with intake of **one section of 60 students** for a period of **one year** i.e. for the academic year **2017-18** subject to following conditions.

The approval for the two courses are only for the year 2017-2018 as university has granted affiliation only for one year i.e. for 2017-18.

Circular in respect of issuing affiliation order to the colleges is attached herewith.

It is surprising, being an old college, but the payment to the teachers of the social science subjects are not only too low, some of them are on 2000 per month and also all of them are part time, which is against the rules. Integrated degree means grant of two degrees, one in BA and other in LL.B. How can an institution teach social science subjects with part time faculty members. The college to appoint regular faculty members and to pay UGC/Government Scale as per the statutory Rules. **The college has to file reply of having complied with the mandatory condition within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of this letter.**

The appointments shall be made of the qualified faculty members having at least masters degree in the subject they are teaching.

The University/College is directed to also fulfill the following conditions, failure of which may lead to subsequent necessary and proper action being taken in this regard.

1. The Institution is directed to establish the Legal Aid Centre as per Clause-11, Schedule-III of Rule-11 of the Part-IV of the Legal Education Rules – 2008.
2. Institution should ensure the payment of salary to teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
3. The institution is directed to upgrade the library as mentioned below :-
“Today with the increasing cost of journals, books, wi-fi, e-library and online facilities including I.T. facilities, the minimum investment by each university should be Rs. 10 lakhs for each year. However any university/deemed university in rural area, it should be Rs. 5 Lakh and for all other affiliated colleges in the urban area it should be Rs. 2 lakhs and in rural area Rs. 1 lakh.”
4. The institution is also directed to upgrade the library by subscribing 10 sets of Indian Bar Review, selected judgments and professional Ethics published by Bar Council of India Trust.
5. Teacher Student ratio shall be as per Schedule-III, Rule-11, Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India Rules.
6. Institution is directed to inform the timings of the classes.
7. Sitting arrangement of participants and visitors should properly be arranged in moot court room. Chair and table of moot court judge is not proper. It should also be up to the mark.

Further, the University/College must specify the timing of the college which has not been given. College should also maintain the timing which has to be minimum 5 ½ hours with half an hour break. College to file an affidavit to the Bar Council of India within six weeks mentioning the timing of the classes. The relevant rules are quoted hereunder :-

Rule (xxiii), Chapter I

“(xxiii) “Regular Course of Study” means and includes a course which runs for at least five hours a day continuously with an additional half an hour recess every day and running not less than thirty hours of working schedule per week.”

Rule 5 of Schedule III

“Classes may be conducted between 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. in an Centre of Legal Education, which is not fully residential. However the Library may remain open till 10 p.m.”

The library should be furnished as per Clause 15 of Schedule III of Legal

Ltd. Central Acts and Local Acts, Criminal law journal, SCC, Company cases, Indian Bar Review, selected Judgements on Professional Ethics and Journals with the back volumes for at least ten years and also such number of text books in each subjects taught during the period according to the minimum standard ratio of ten books for each registered students. For running integrated program, text books of such other subjects are also to be kept in the similar minimum ratio.

Further, the institution should follow the attendance rule and file reply that they are following the aforesaid rule. The next inspection team must also see whether the said rule is being followed by the university or not. The relevant Rule 12 is given below :-

"12. End Semester Test: No student of any of the degree program shall be allowed to take the end semester test in a subject if the student concerned has not attended minimum of 70% of the classes held in the subject concerned as also the moot court room exercises, tutorials and practical training conducted in the subject taken together.

Provided that if a student for any exceptional reasons fail to attend 70% of the classes held in any subject, the Dean of the University or the Principal of the Centre of Legal Education, as the case may be, may allow the student to take the test if the student concerned attended at least 65% of the classes held in the subject concerned and attended 70% of classes in all the subjects taken together. The similar power shall rest with the Vice Chancellor or Director of a National Law University, or his authorized representative in the absence of the Dean of Law.

Provided further that a list of such students allowed to take the test with reasons recorded be forwarded to the Bar Council of India."

University/College should also admit students as per the below mentioned Rule:

7. Minimum marks in qualifying examination for admission: Bar Council of India may from time to time, stipulate the minimum percentage of marks not below 45% of the total marks in case of general category applicants, 42% for OBC category and 40% of the total marks in case of SC and ST applicants, to be obtained for the qualifying examination, such as +2 Examination in case of Integrated Five Years' course or Degree course in any discipline for Three years' LL.B. course, for the purpose of applying for and getting admitted into a Law Degree Program of any recognized University in either of the streams.




