On the occasion of the Birth Anniversary of the ‘Father of the Nation’ Mahatma Gandhi and former Prime Minister Lal Bahadur Shastri Ji, the portraits of these two great personalities were garlanded. All the dignitaries made a floral tribute to the portrait of Mahatma Gandhi and Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri. All teaching and non-teaching staff and few students offered pushpanjali to Mahatma Gandhi and Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri.

It was followed by Oath taking ceremony, which was carried by the programme co-ordinator Sri P. C. Murugeshappa, Physical Director, who announced let's *pledge* to uphold the values of patriotism and integrity in every aspect of life.

It was further followed by inspiring speech delivered by K. Thippeswamy of 3 years Final Year LL. B. student, he shared the life history of Mahatma Gandhi.

Prof. Dr. M. S. Sudhadevi, Principal, addressed the gathering and said every year on October 2nd, India not only celebrates the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi but also honours another great leader—Lal Bahadur Shastri, the nation’s second Prime Minister. Lal Bahadur Shastri Jayanti is a day of remembrance and reverence for a man who embodied simplicity,

integrity, and dedication to the country. His tenure as Prime Minister, though brief, left a lasting impact on India's history, most notably with the inspiring slogan "Jai Jawan Jai Kisan," which rallied both soldiers and farmers during a pivotal time in the nation's growth.

Sri. H. Hanumanthappa Former Member of Rajya Sabha President, Saraswathi Education Society (R), Chitradurga, in his presedential speech said Lal Bahadur Shastri was the Second Prime Minister of India, after Jawaharlal Nehru. He was in office from June 9, 1964, till his death on January 11, 1966. Born on October 2, 1904, he shares his birthday with Mahatma Gandhi, of whom Shastri was an ardent follower. He was also the Minister of External Affairs from April 1961 to August 1963, and then the Minister of External Affairs from June 1964 to July 1964. He urged the students to learn the values and principles, which Gandhiji and Shastriji held dear in their life, like truth, non-violence, respect for all beings, self-discipline, unity, harmony, sharing and caring. The students got motivated to follow the footsteps of these great personalities in every walk of life. Going a step forward in helping the students understand all about the freedom struggle and the role of Mahatama Gandhi in helping us win our independence non-violently, the students were given a deep insight into the life and times of Mahatama Gandhi and encouraged to think about the sacrifice of our freedom fighters, analyze the importance and understand the value of freedom, through the day's activities.

## **Report on Awareness Programme on the occasion of 'National Legal Services Day'**

Date: 09.11.2024

The Institution, had celebrated National Legal Services Day on 9<sup>th</sup> November 2024. This is to commemorate the enactment of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 that came into effect on 9 November 1995. This National Legal Services Day plays an important role in the implementation of objectives through the process of organizing legal awareness programme, and other outreach programs. With this concept Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga in collaboration with Girls Junior High School and College, Chitradurga had organized the Legal Awareness programme on this occasion for 9<sup>th</sup> Std., students.

The Programme was compared by Sri P. C. Murugeshappa, Physical Education Director, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga. Sri Sandesh J.R, Assistant Professor, Saraswathi Law College was the coordinator of the programme who, delivered the Welcome speech.

The Programme was inaugurated by watering to the plant by Sri Kariyanna, Head Master, Government Girls High School, Chitradurga, and other dignitaries on the dais.

Sri Kariyanna delivered the inaugural address and said the most important objective of National Legal Services Day is to empower people to be more aware of legal rights and mechanisms for resolving disputes. It emphasizes that an economically disabled person should not be deprived of representation in court. On this very day, various arrangements have been made so that awareness is generated about free legal services and equal access to justice.

Smt. Harsha. S.M, Assistant Professor, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga said that the main purpose of this Awareness Programme was to sensitize the general masses, especially Children about the importance of Prevention of Child Marriages in India. She threw light on few provisions of Prohibition of Child Marriage Act 2005, by narrating a short story impressing upon the gathering especially Children and Women victims to come forward and approach various Legal Services Institutions for redressal of their grievances. She also apprised the beneficiaries about the free legal aid services by District Legal Services Authority and informing about the free helpline number 1098 and 112.

Prof. Dr. M.S. Sudhadevi, Principal, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga had presided the programme. She explained that The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, enacted in 2012 in India, is a comprehensive law aimed at protecting children from sexual abuse and exploitation. It defines various forms of sexual offenses against children and prescribes stringent punishments for offenders. The act also mandates special procedures for the reporting, recording and trial of offenses to ensure the safety and well-being of child victims throughout the legal process. She further discussed about good touch and bad touch explaining in detail both and why is it important for every child to know the difference between both.

Then the Students of Saraswathi Law College performed the wonderful skit, which exhibited the Sexual harassment, Child Marriage and its effects, Dowry harassment, in a short span of time, which was marvelously presented and created Awareness for the audience. The skit was appreciated with a big applause by the gathering. The programme was concluded by vote of thanks. Around 50 students took benefit of the programme.



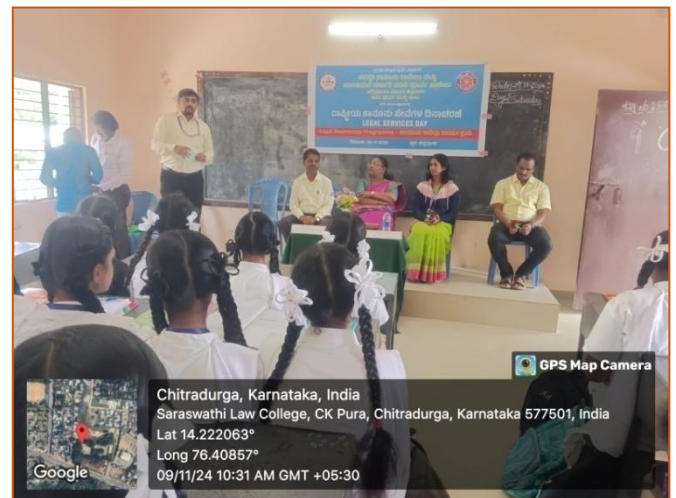

**Date: 16.11.2024**

The Institution, had Organized the International Day for Tolerance on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2024. It was started by the UN General Assembly, with the goal of getting educational institutions and the general public to see tolerance as a staple of society. The programme was compared by Sakku Bai. B and Heena Kousar. M.S of 3 years Final Year LL.B students, who welcomed the gathering by stating that In 1995, UNESCO created the Declaration of Principles on Tolerance as a way to define and provide awareness of tolerance for any and all governing and participating bodies on 16<sup>th</sup> November. Now, as an anniversary of that Declaration, we celebrate the International Day for Tolerance on November 16<sup>th</sup> to help spread tolerance and raise awareness of any intolerance that may still be prevalent in the society today.

Prof. Dr. M. S. Sudhadevi, Principal, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga was the Chief Guest of the Programme. She addressed the gathering and said, This declaration points out that education is an important and powerful tool that can help spread tolerance among individuals and that it is also an effective way to prevent intolerance. Furthermore, education “should aim at countering influences that lead to fear and exclusion of others, and should help young people develop capacities for independent judgment, critical thinking and ethical reasoning”. Smt. 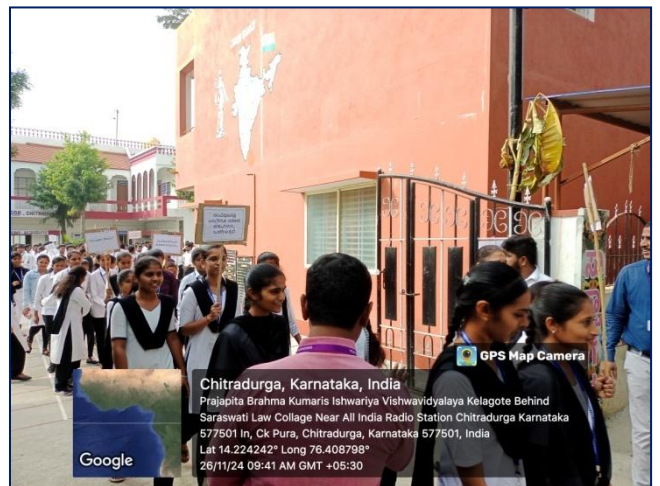

**Date: 05/06/2025**

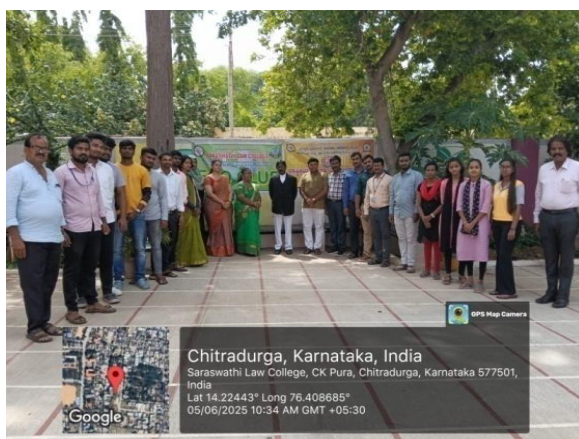

**Date: 21/07/2025**

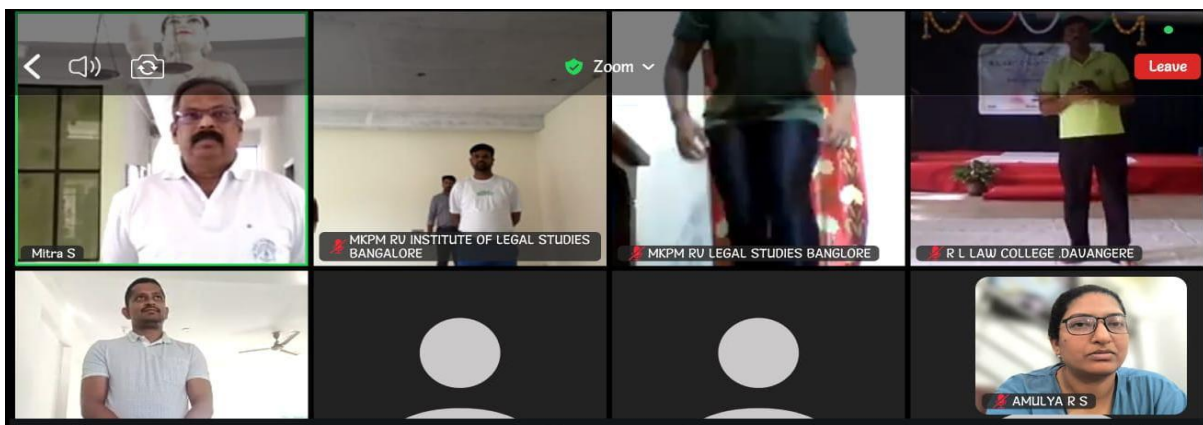
