## **Inaugural Session**

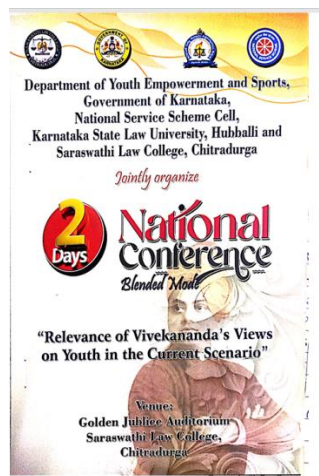

- A number of insightful presentations addressed **youth empowerment through service**, linking Swami Vivekananda's call for selfless action to modern social initiatives and volunteerism.

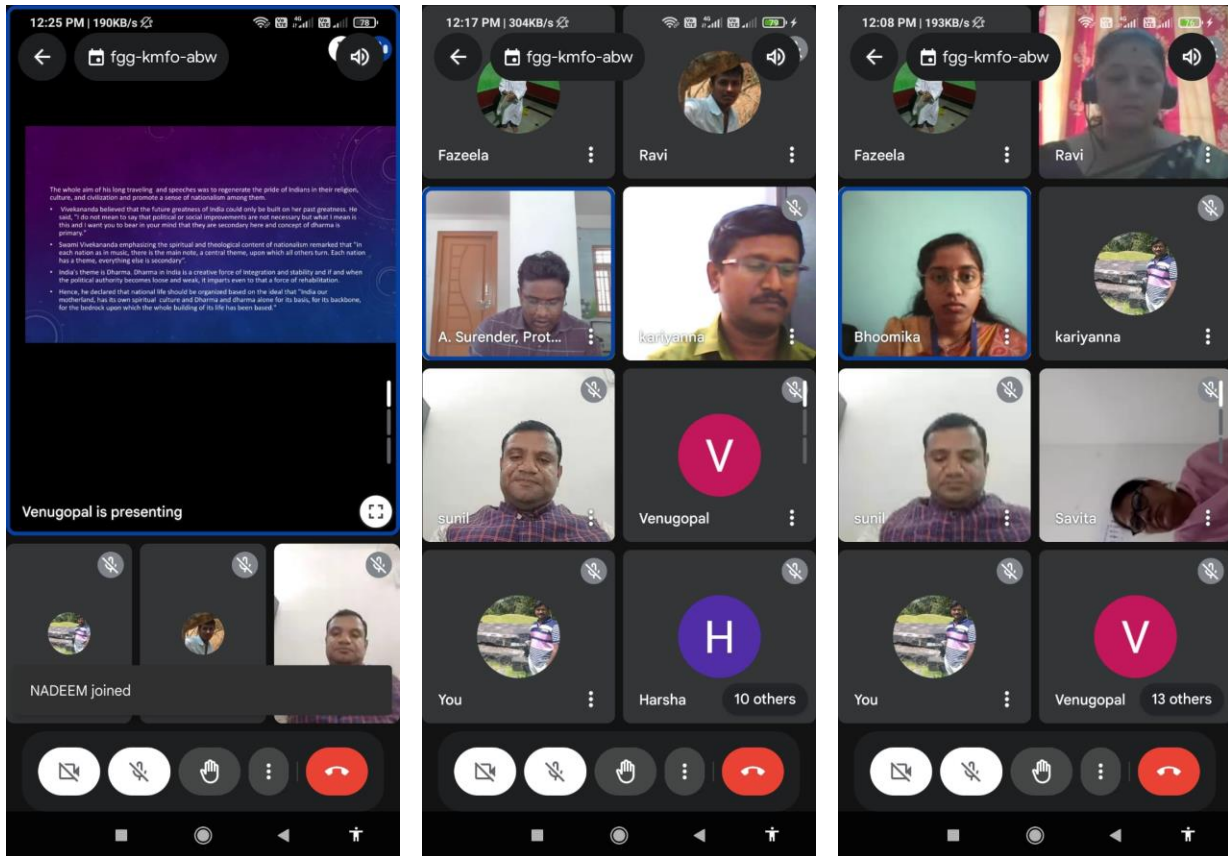

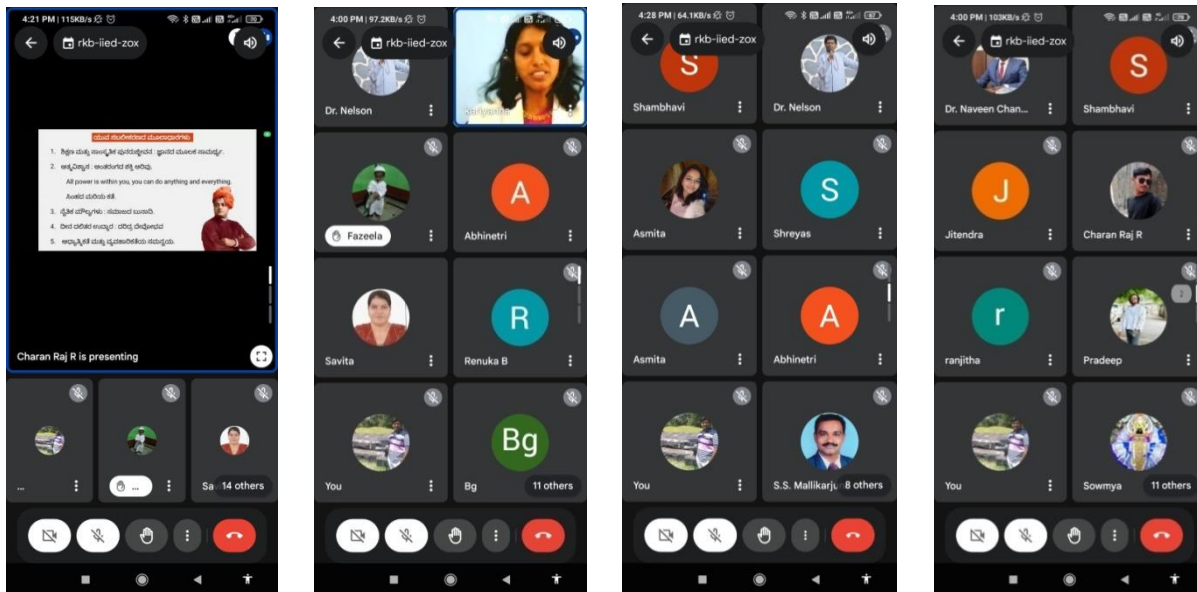
