

Report on the International Model United Nations Conference on "The Role of Youth in Involving in the Green Economy, Green Energy, Green Jobs, and Green Transition"

The Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga has organized The International Model United Nations Conference on “The Role of Youth in Involving in the Green Economy, Green Energy, Green Jobs, and Green Transition” in association with The Organisation of Green Future, Afganistan. This conference was convened with the aim of highlighting the critical role that the younger generation plays in driving sustainable development and addressing climate change. The event brought together passionate students, young leaders, and experts in the fields of sustainability, environmentalism, and economics to discuss ways in which youth can actively participate in and promote the green economy.

The conference provided a platform for delegates to engage in thought-provoking discussions, share innovative ideas, and explore practical solutions that could contribute to a more sustainable and green future. Emphasis was placed on the importance of youth leadership in advancing the global transition towards sustainable energy solutions and green job creation, alongside the opportunities and challenges that young people face in contributing to these areas.

I Session:

1. The programme began with the Inaugural session at 02.00 p.m. Dr. N. D. Gowda, Assistant Professor, Saraswathi Law College, Chitradurga delivered the welcome speech. Bhavna Mahadew, Lecture in Law, Adjunct Professor (BSIBER INDIA), Department of Business Management and Law, School of Business, Management and Finance, University of Technology, Mauritius gave a keynote address. The keynote speaker kicked off the conference by discussing the urgency of addressing climate change and the need for systemic transformation in industries worldwide. They stressed the unique opportunity for youth to be at the forefront of this transition and how innovation and creativity are essential in the green economy.

Mr. Mykola Chernohorov, Global Promotion Leader at Nobel Learning PBC with the experience of leading more than 15 teams in 15 countries of the world was the Chief Guest of the programme, he highlighted the objectives of the conference

as - To understand the significance of the green economy and the role of youth in shaping it, To explore how young people can be empowered to participate in the green energy sector, To promote the creation of green jobs and the role youth can play in fostering a sustainable workforce, To examine the challenges and opportunities that youth face in contributing to the green transition, To advocate for youth involvement in policy-making and decision-making processes related to environmental sustainability.

Dr. Nisha Bhaskar and Prof. (Dr.) Daniel Hamilton Fernandes de Lima focused on Green Economy and Sustainable Development – Challenges and Opportunities for Youth. They explored how the green economy represents both a challenge and an opportunity for young people. Discussions centered around the economic advantages of transitioning to green industries, such as sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, and eco-tourism. Youth delegates were encouraged to leverage education and innovation to drive green entrepreneurship and economic growth.

2. Prof. (Dr.) Maruthi TR, Professor of International Law, Department of Studies in Law University of Mysore, Mysore, Presided the programme. He focused on Green Jobs and Skill Development for Youth in a Sustainable Workforce. A panel of experts discussed the importance of preparing the workforce for green jobs and how young people can acquire the necessary skills for roles in industries such as clean energy, sustainable agriculture, and green technology. Youth delegates discussed strategies to improve access to training, education, and mentorship programs that can help them transition into green careers.

II Session:

The second session was led by Ms. Jhanvi Suresh by reading the proceeding. It was followed by report by the rapporteur i.e. Ms. Masoma Rezaye. They put a light on Green Energy and Youth Leadership in Advancing Sustainable Solutions. This session focused on renewable energy sources, such as solar, wind, and hydropower, and how youth can actively participate in promoting and adopting these technologies. Delegates heard from experts in the energy sector who highlighted successful youth-led initiatives, such as youth-driven renewable energy startups and advocacy campaigns for cleaner energy policies.

III Session:
